## Our President's Message

While the car show scene slows down the first part of the year in Northern California, it does not mean there isn't anything for the gearhead to do. Some of our members are working on their cars, getting them ready for our show season.

January is also when numerous auto auctions are held around the country, many of them televised, starting with auction week in Scottsdale, Arizona. Barrett Jackson is the best known auction, but there are a number of other companies holding auctions at the same time. This year's results indicate our hobby is in good health. Barrett Jackson sold 1611 cars for 130 million and 2000+ pieces of Automobila for 6.55 million. The Ron Pratt collection alone netted 40.44 million. Barrett Jackson raised \$8,735,000 for charity. In total, during the week, 42 cars sold for over 1 million dollars each with the top selling car a 1964 Ferrari 250LM for \$9,625,000 at RM Auctions. (like the Ferrari at the right)

At our January meeting, a change in our by-laws was approved, that will enable prospective members who are working on their 1972 and older American-made vehicles, that are not running at this time, to be able to join our Club.

At our meeting in February we will elect a Treasurer, Activities Director, Membership Director, and Member at Large. At this time we still are looking for someone to step up and volunteer to run for Activities Director.

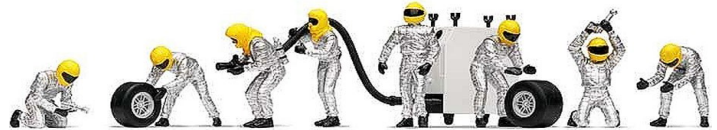
