PROPOSAL FOR CHANGE TO THE RODS & RELICS OF LINCOLN HILLS CAR CLUB BY-LAWS  
Your Board Members are recommending we increase our dues.

X. - FINANCIAL of the Rods & Relics Lincoln Hills car club Bylaws . Proposed annual dues be increased from \$25 to \$40. Proposed changes to the Bylaws are as follows:

FINANCIAL

**Regular** Member dues are ~~\$25 per member household.~~ \$40 per member household.

· Associate Member dues are ~~\$25 per member household.~~ \$40 per member household.

Annual dues are payable by 1 July.

Dues for new members inducted after January 1 are \$12.50 to \$20.

Members leaving the Club for any reason are not entitled to a refund.

A minimum of two members of the Board of Directors shall register their signature with the Club's bank.

The proposed changes were read to members attending the May 16 meeting and opened for discussion. The changes will be put to a vote at the June Membership meeting. If approved, the increase will be effective for the 2019 - 2010 registration period.

With no further business to discuss, President Chuck Barnhart adjourned the meeting at 6:45 PM
